



Jekyll Island residential lease collection

Biography:

During the 1950s, the Jekyll Island State Park Authority leased lots on Jekyll Island to private residents. These lot leases were maintained within the Jekyll Island Authority Administration offices. The majority of this collection was transferred to the archives from the Authority offices. Additional materials were found within old state records boxes during a records reconciliation project. This material was filed in its appropriate place within the collection.

Scope and Content:

This collection contains paper materials that cover the original leases issued to build homes on Jekyll Island during the early state era.
