Biography:

The Jekyll Island State Park Authority was established by Governor Talmadge in 1950 as the governing body of Jekyll Island. The Authority was tasked with developing the island into a resort in the early state era and oversaw its management and growth to present day. The JIA operates as a self-supporting state agency with members appointed by the Governor and serving four-year terms. The board documents its meetings and has since its inception in 1950.

Scope and Content:

This collection contains board minutes of the Jekyll Island State Park Authority board meetings. This collection begins in 1950, at the boards inception and continues through present day. Please note the two most recent years of board minutes are held on the Authority website, until they are transferred to the archives.
